## Character Trait of the Month: Honesty



**Definition:** being truthful, right-minded

**What it means?** An honest person tells the truth ALL the time - not just when it is convenient. We already see children 3 & 4 years old who sometimes have a hard time being honest - especially if they have done something wrong. The best way to teach children to be honest is to model it for them! Teach your child by example that it is NEVER acceptable to tell a lie.
